2024 Slingerland[®] Summer Learning Program

General Description of Program and Student Eligibility:

This program is for students **who have completed grades two, three, four, five, or six**. All students must be recommended for the program by either parents, teachers, or clinicians due to observed difficulties in one or more areas of penmanship, letter-sound-symbol association for reading or spelling, written expression, decoding, reading fluency, or reading comprehension. <u>Students will be accepted</u> into the program once their application and associated Slingerland[®] Screening and /or neuropsychological or other clinical evaluation is submitted and reviewed by the summer school program director for goodness-of-fit.

The Slingerland[®]Approach is a multi-modal (multi-sensory) Structured Literacy approach to teaching language arts - reading, writing, speaking, and spelling. Procedures to establish and extend competence in each of the areas noted above are systematically introduced and practiced. The first 10 minutes of the academic day are devoted to concise oral language expression (Question of the Day). This allows students to practice organizing their thoughts and responding to questions in full and complete sentences. Next, instruction progresses to a structured lesson to develop spelling (encoding, understanding base words, affixes, and suffixes) and written language skills. Students do a lot of cursive writing practice to ensure automatic sound-symbol understanding and written letter formation. The final portion of the lesson is devoted to reading, reading fluency, and reading comprehension. Each day consists of 150 minutes of Slingerland[®] instruction, as well as a 30-minute snack/activity break. No homework is assigned as students work quite hard while in class.

Class hours are 9:00 am to 12:00 pm each day. The playground gate is opened at 8:45 am to allow students time to enter, drop off their things, and use the restroom/ wash their hands before the start of their lessons. Students must be picked up promptly at dismissal. Parents/drivers are to wait on the sidewalk by the playground gate to help escort their students through the parking lot. There is no Ohlone College parking fee for families dropping off or picking up students. There is no provision for before or after-school care. Special weekly activities will be announced in Friday Family Updates. During the final week of summer school, parents/families are invited to observe the morning Slingerland®lesson followed by a general conference presentation with all parents. Individual student reports will be sent home on the last day of the summer program.
